AGRIHERITAGE seeks to tackle the challenge of sustainable preservation of cultural heritage, while aiming to increase the amount of visitors in the programme area. In many rural farms, inherited traditions are still maintained. The project sees potential for cross-border heritage agritourism in the form of farm museums, guided excursions and master classes to demonstrate the state of contemporary traditional heritage farming, while also providing onsite tourist accommodation. The project will ensure that farms are linked in cross-border tour itineraries, highlighting the rich variety of agricultural heritage in different regions. Groups and individual travellers are encouraged to visit and stay in the programme area.
