Summary of the project

SCAPE aims to improve public safety in the project area by improving skills for national security services and local government employees, by using modern technology in their daily work. The goal of the project then is to promote communication and cooperation between police and local governments along the Latvian-Lithuanian border, which is envisioned to not only increase security, but also the popularity of the region. In order to strengthen knowledge and capacity, 70 police officers and a total of 60 volunteers will participate in three joint trainings on how to use and apply modern technologies. These trainings will be given by local and foreign professional instructors and lecturers. In addition to this, a conference will be organised, where the exchange of experiences among different stakeholders will be possible.
